

ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING E-LOBBYIST ENHANCEMENTS

In response to several concerns and suggestions from users, we are pleased to announce that effective June 2, 2015, there will be various enhancements to the e-Lobbyist electronic filing system, including:

- A free-form search box will be added to the client selection page allowing the user to search for a client without having to scroll through the pre-populated list.
- A pre-populated drop-down list of client business industries will be added to the statement of registration page. Please select the industry that best fits the client's business.
- It will no longer be mandatory to list the target's contact name on the statement of registration. However, if you know the target's contact name, you must enter the information in the statement of registration.
- Various text changes were made to confirmation emails, the enrollment page, the retainer agreement page and other screens.

We will continue to work with the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications to improve the e-Lobbyist system based on your concerns and suggestions. Thank you for your cooperation.
